#### SECTION A

## MATTERS ARISING FROM MINUTES OF THE LAST MEETING

The minutes were accepted and the points arising are noted in the various reports apart from:

- Jon is going to the "Lock" shop to see if we can synchronise the replaced lock.(ongoing)
- A Budget for rubbish collection is being created
- Pathways are now accepting payment by BACS.

### CHAIRMAN'S REPORT

- 1. Attended EAP (Ealing Allotment Partnership) meeting they want to foster more co-operation between sites. They are also considering more self management and perhaps a federation to co-ordinate all their sites.

  - Plot 234B agreed to give up the plot. He is acting as a carer for his aunt with dementia and so has no time. I said I would put him back on the waiting list and he'll contact me when he is ready to try again.

### JON'S REPORT

#### RUBBISH

- After much deliberation we are having a skip straight away to clear the rubbish from the volunteer day.
- Christina has done a lot of research including the service provided by Ealing Council
- We are going to try a "wheelie bin" system on a three month contract to see how it goes. It is the only one that gives the possibility of collection in the summer but not in the winter.
